THE RULES OF CHESS

Chess is a game for two players One player controls the white pieces and the other player controls the black pieces Traditionally, players start the game by shaking hands with their opponent White always moves first and then players take turns (white then black then white, etc) Turns consist of moving a

first rank is also the first rank on the board Explain ranks by counting rows, showing that Black's fifth rank is White's fourth rank, and the fourth rank on the board Notice that each player's first rank is the other's eighth and last rank In chess, White always moves first and the players always alternate turns

Chess openings The first few moves in a game are extremely important They can have a big influence over who wins and who loses Opening tips If you're White, you have an advantage: you move first, so you can create threats that Black has to respond to Try to f10ff onto this advantage Take control of the central squares on the board
