Be consistent with your CV layout; Set one-inch margins for all four sides. Make sure your CV headings are uniform—make them larger and in bold but go easy on italics and underlining. Stick to a single dates format on your CV: for example 11-2017, or November 2017. Don't cram your CV with gimmicky graphics; Less is more.

Try to arrange your sections so that they highlight your strengths in relation to the position you are applying to. Make sure your font is readable and that you are consistent with any formatting you decide to use. Don't include your salary history in your CV.
