### **UpToDate**

Doxycycline 100 mg twice daily (conditional recommendation) or. Macrolide (conditional recommendations and only in areas with pneumococcal resistance to macrolides <25%): Azithromycin 500 mg on first day then 250 mg daily or clarithromycin 500 mg twice daily or clarithromycin extended release 1,000 mg daily.

### **Guideline for the Treatment of Community-Acquired ...**

For such patients, recommended empiricaltherapeutic options include (1) a respiratory fluoroquinolone (moxifloxacin, gemifloxacin, or levofloxacin [750 mg daily]) or (2) combination therapy with a b-lactam effective against *S. pneumoniae* plus a macrolide (doxycycline as an alternative).

### **Practice Guidelines - IDSA**

In a study conducted in a Sydney, Australia, teaching hospital, most patients hospitalized with CAP were initially prescribed 2 antibiotics, and then after completing IV therapy, 62% of these patients were prescribed 2 oral agents, 27% were prescribed 1 oral agent, and 11% were not prescribed any sequential therapy.

**INTRODUCTION** — Community-acquired pneumonia (CAP) is a leading cause of morbidity and mortality worldwide. The clinical presentation of CAP varies, ranging from mild pneumonia characterized by fever and productive cough to severe pneumonia characterized by respiratory distress and sepsis.
